The Welsh Government is implementing this law to enhance the efficiency and volume of waste collection and separation. 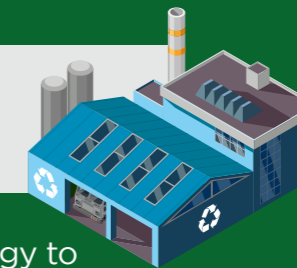

As part of our continued investment strategy to improve our service to customers, in May 2023, we commissioned a bespoke recycling line in Deeside. This facility allows us to shred, wash, segregate and granulate end of life plastic products along with unused materials, which include both HD and PP among others.

This involved demonstrating our focus on driver and vehicle safety, as well as enhancing operational efficiency through the effective monitoring of fuel and tyre usage.

New Recycling Laws in WALES - Are you Ready?

From 6 April 2024, it will become law for all businesses, charities and public sector organisations in Wales to sort their waste for recycling. Waste and recycling collectors are on board too!

Waste that Needs to be Separated

- Food
- Paper and card
- Glass
- Metal, plastic and cartons
- Unsold textiles
- Unsold small waste electrical & electronic equipment (sWEEE)

Ban Alert

- NO sending food waste to sewers
- NO incineration or landfill for separately collected waste
- ALL wood waste stays out of landfills
- Mix paper and card; mix metal, plastic, and cartons

Who Does the Law Apply to:

- All businesses, charities and public sector organisations
- Agricultural premises
- Hospitality and tourism
- Showgrounds
- Service stations and petrol stations
- Entertainment and sports venues including leisure centres
- Transport - bus stations, railway stations, seaports, airports, and heliports
- Care and nursing homes
- Pharmacies, GP surgeries, dental surgeries, and other primary care settings
- Construction sites
- Factories and warehouses
- Car garages
- Education - universities, colleges, & schools
- Garden centres
- Heritage buildings
- Libraries and museums
- Offices and workshops
- Places of worship
- Prisons
- Outdoor markets and festivals
- Retail
